



SEDCOR is one of the leading agencies in Oregon to utilize Energy Efficiency Grants from the USDA.

In fiscal year 2007, over \$19.1 million in 9006 grants were awarded. Energy efficiency projects are very competitive, in 2006 2/3 of all grants went to energy efficiency projects (averaging \$17,350). Now in 2008, SEDCOR has helped several of its members who are undertaking energy efficiency projects, submit applications to USDA for some of the grant funds. To date, SEDCOR has helped members apply for more than \$80,000 in grant funds. These members are across the board from manufacturing to agriculture.

If less than \$200,000, the process requires an energy audit. A qualified electrical contractor normally can handle this. This USDA program can be used in combination with Energy Trust and BETC energy tax credits. This can help to substantially reduce the cost of becoming energy efficient in your operation.
